Voting Schedule and Highlights



Will Browne is a Chicago-based Flight Attendant and serves as the Chairperson of the TWU Local 556 Board of Election (BOE).

The Tentative Agreement (TA) Ratification Vote will be conducted electronically or over the phone using Votenet Solutions. A ballot package will be mailed to each Member's last known address.

- Votes may be cast electronically via Internet or telephone starting on July 13, 2015 at 1200 Central.
- Votes must be cast by 1200 Central on July 24, 2015.
- Any Member who does not receive a ballot may request a duplicate ballot credential by contacting Votenet Solutions at 800-404-5750 (toll free within the U.S.) or 202-207-0538 (from outside the U.S.).
- It is the responsibility of each Member to advise the Union of any change of address. If you have moved in the last 30 days, you will need to contact Votenet in order to receive your voting credentials.
- For voting credential or operational assistance during the voting period, please call Votenet Solutions at 800-404-5750

(toll-free) or 202-207-0538. For any other questions please contact the Board of Election at 800-969-7932 extension 4324 or via email at BoardOfElection@twu556.org.

- Probationary and Agency-fee Flight Attendants may not vote, but they will be mailed a ballot for informational purposes.
- All Flight Attendants on any type of leave are eligible to participate in the vote.
- **You may only vote ONCE.**

- Make sure you exercise your right to vote on this important Tentative Agreement, and please remind your Co-workers to vote as well.
- Voting results will be announced by 1800 Central on July 24, 2015.
